

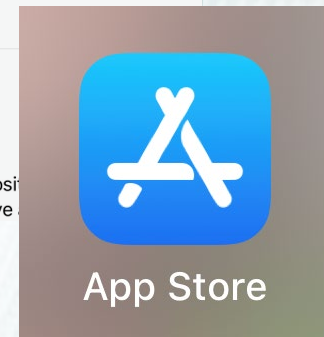

---

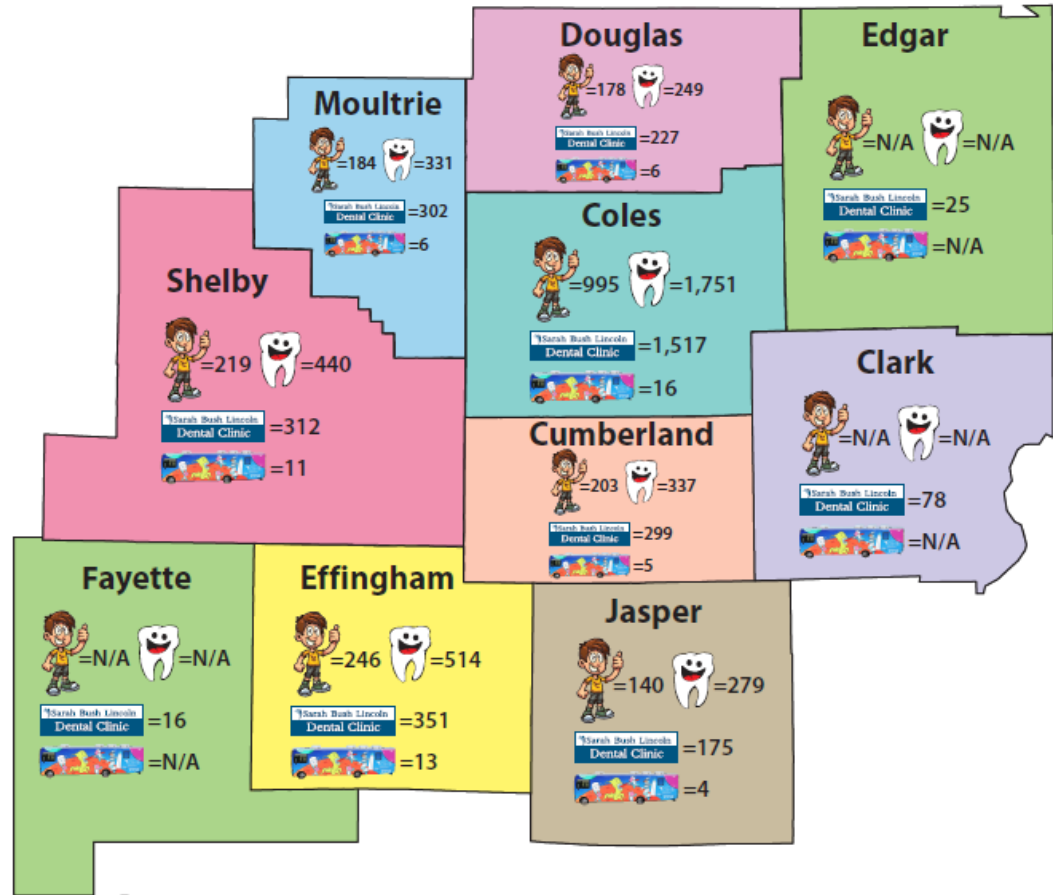
